SPACE RESERVATION GUIDELINES

- DATES:** Saturday, September 18, 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Sunday, September 19, 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- LOCATION:** Depot Park, Clarkston, MI.
- MEDIA:** Multimedia. All works must be **HAND-CRAFTED BY THE EXHIBITOR** and must be of **ORIGINAL DESIGN**. Absolutely no kits. Ten spaces will be reserved for high-quality packaged products (i.e. herbs, food products, dried flowers).
- FEE:** \$150 fee per space required or take advantage of discount pricing of \$250 for two spaces. Spaces are 10 x 10 in area. Payment is due with application. Checks payable to Clarkston Community Historical Society. Checks will be cashed no earlier than April 15, 2010 if accepted into the show, otherwise will be returned with photos.
- ENTRY:** Applications due by March 15, 2010. This is a juried show. Your application must include at least three photos including a work-in-progress photo which shows your work area and partially completed work. It is to your benefit to include photos which show the quality of your work. A **STAMPED, SELF-ADDRESSED ENVELOPE** must be included with application for the return of your photos. Please use sufficient postage for the photos on the return envelope. Notification of acceptance will be on or before April 30, 2010.
- RULES:** Artists must exhibit both days or forfeit the opportunity to exhibit in the future. All display equipment to be provided by artist, including sun/rain protection and a sign identifying the artist. Set-up must be completed and all vehicles moved to specified parking areas by 9:00 a.m. each day. Restrooms and food vendors are available. Relief is provided by volunteers if requested on application (pre-registration is required). Electricity is not available, generators are not permitted.
- SPACES:** Spaces will be assigned at time of acceptance. Use map on reverse to request a specific location if desired (shaded numbers 1-83 only, unless food vendor). If more than one space is needed, please indicate this on the space reservation form (see FEE above for double space discount). Artists are not permitted to place displays out of assigned spaces. If more than one artist requests the same space it will be assigned to the first application received (per postmark). The nearest available space will be assigned if first or second choices are full.
- JUDGING:** All entries will be reviewed by a jury. The jury reserves the right to reject any entry and to limit the number of entries per category. Any items that are not juried will not be permitted in the show. Any person who misrepresents his/her work will be excluded from the show. In the event that an artist is not accepted due to lack of available space, he/she can request to be placed on the waiting list.
