MEDIA

Multimedia. All works must be **HAND-CRAFTED BY THE EXHIBITOR** and must be of **ORIGINAL DESIGN**. Absolutely no kits. Ten spaces will be reserved for high-quality packaged products (*i.e. herbs, food products, dried flowers*).

BOOTH FEE

\$200 Fee per space required or take advantage of discount pricing of \$350 for two spaces. Spaces are 10' x 10' in area. Payment due with application. Checks payable to Clarkston Community Historical Society. Checks will be cashed no earlier than June 4, 2018 if accepted into the show. A \$25 fee will be applied for checks bounced by the bank. If you are not accepted then your check will be returned with your photos. **Receive a \$25 booth fee credit if you refer an artist who is accepted into and participates in the show.**

ENTRY

Applications are due by June 4, 2018. This is a juried show. Your application must include at least four photos. One photo **must** be a work-in-progress which shows your work area and partially completed work. A **STAMPED, SELF-ADDRESSED ENVELOPE** must be included with application for the return of your photos (use sufficient postage). Notification of acceptance/rejection will be on or before June 13, 2018.

SPACES

Booth location will be assigned at time of acceptance. Use the map included in this packet to request a specific booth. Please be aware that the numbers have changed this year. Artist may request spaces by using the booth number (#66 - #79 are generally assigned to Marketplace vendors). Should two artists request the same space, it will be assigned to the artist with the earliest post mark on their application. The nearest available space will then be assigned if first or second choices are unavailable.

JUDGING

All entries will be reviewed by a jury. The jury reserves the right to reject any entry and to limit the number of entries in any category. It is to the artist's advantage to submit clear photos which indicate the quality of the work. Each photo should be identified. Any items that are not juried will not be permitted in the show. Any person who misrepresents his/her work will be excluded from the show. Decisions of the jury are final. In the event that an artist is not accepted due to lack of available space, his/her name will be placed on a wait list and contacted if a space does become available.
