

2021 Artist Rules

Rule 1: Exhibitors must comply with all local ordinances, regulations, and laws. No alcohol is permitted in Depot Park. Rude or obscene language/behavior will result in your immediate removal from the park.

Rule 2: Booth spaces may not be transferred or otherwise reassigned by the artist.

Rule 3: By two hours prior to the show opening on the show's first day, artists must have claimed (by their presence) their booth space. Otherwise, unclaimed spaces may be resold with no refund issued.

Rule 4: TENT STAKES ARE STRICTLY PROHIBITED. Using tent stakes will result in a fine of \$100. This is a park rule to protect the sprinkler system lines.

Rule 5: Booths must remain open during the entire show (no matter the weather) unless CCHS declares an emergency.

Rule 6: Booth structure and display must not exceed the limits of the assigned space. If your artwork is hazardous or interferes with your neighbor, you must remove it.

Rule 7: All inventory must be neatly concealed within your booth space.

Rule 8: Please leave any debris/boxes in or near one of the trash receptacles.

Rule 9: Artists cannot use sidewalks, trees or the gazebo for additional display space.

Rule Violations: If you break the rules we will give you a warning and ask that you remedy the issue. If the problem is not fixed we reserve the right to close your booth immediately and you will vacate the space at the end of that day. All fees will be forfeited.
