

2022 ARTIST Exhibitor Rules

- Exhibitors must comply with all local ordinances, regulations and laws. No alcoholic beverages, open fire or foul language is allowed in Depot Park.
- Booth spaces may not be transferred or reassigned by the exhibitor.
- The show will remain open for both days regardless of the weather. You must be ready to open by 10 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday.
- You must use weights, **no stakes** are allowed in the park.
- All storage must be neatly concealed and any trash left in trash receptacles.
- BOOTH SPACES are 10' x 10' . We will endeavor to put a little more space between tents whenever possible.
- Booth space will be assigned at the time of acceptance. All contracts must be received by June 1, 2022.
- You cannot drive to your booth, be PREPARED. We will have limited staff on hand to help when possible.
- After you have unloaded, vendor vehicles are expected to park at the designated lot. On show days a shuttle will be running to take you from your car to the park during designated times. Shuttle times will be provided during check-in. This allows maximum parking for shoppers and benefits YOU.
- **Cancellations** BEFORE August 15 will result in a full refund. Cancellations AFTER August 15 will not be refunded.
